### **Job Summary**

Tends dipping tanks and auxiliary equipment that immerse and coat parts with paint by performing the following duties.

### **Duties/Responsibilities**

#### **DUTIES**

- Tends parts washer, adjusts wash water pH to specifications
- Cleans wash tank
- Maintains conveyor system to move parts through the paint process
- Racks and unracks parts prior to and after painting
- Responsible for accurate time reporting
- Responsible for keeping work area and machinery clean and in good order
- Ensures all machine safeguarding is in position and working properly before starting production and reports any missing, broken, or malfunctioning safety equipment to the department supervisor so that repairs can be made before any production is run on that piece of equipment
- Inspects work pieces to insure quality standards and reports to supervisor any unusual conditions or defects
- Starts press and observes operation to detect misalignment or malfunction
- Performs daily minor maintenance functions and reports more serious items to supervisor
- Dips articles in paint and cleans areas where excess paint drips off
- Disposes of paint waste according to procedure
- Tests quality of liquid. Adds coating solution according to test results or specifications
- Cleans wire paint racks by burning them off in paint rack furnace
- Keeps track of paint inventory
