Operates power press to trim, punch, shape, notch, draw or crimp metal, composite or plastic stock by performing the following duties.

- Performs blanking, piercing and forming operations on a variety of parts
- Positions work piece against fixtures or stops on the die
- Inspects work pieces to insure quality standards and reports to supervisor any unusual conditions or defects
- Responsible for accurate time reporting
- Responsible for keeping work area and machinery clean and in good order
- Reports maintenance items to supervisor
- Ensures all machine safeguarding is in position and working properly before starting production and reports any missing, broken, or malfunctioning safety equipment to the department supervisor so that repairs can be made before any production is run on that piece of equipment
